CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

Pre-K Mixed Media: In this awesome class we will be working with all different types of media including paint, paper mache, charcoal, drawing, mosaic and more! Study famous artists, art appreciation and history. Included is a period of games and activities designed to help children focus.

Mixed Media: Work in a variety of techniques with all different types of media such as paint, clay, paper mache, drawing, water colors, mosaics and more! Study famous artists and learn art appreciation as well as art history and art movement.

Cartooning: Learn drawing techniques like Illustrations, Cartooning, Sequential Art, Comic Panels and Flip books while studying fun and popular cartoon figures. Learn important drawing techniques with a fun cartoon twist that works with all drawing mediums such as pencil, oil pastel, chalk pastel and more! Learn about different artists and genres.

Musical Theatre: Learn spoken dialogue, acting, dance choreography, and singing. The story and emotional content of the piece – humor, pathos, love, anger – are communicated through the words, music, movement and technical aspects of the entertainment as an integrated whole. A great class for boys and girls! Several performances throughout the year. Dress Code: Any comfortable and moveable clothing, tennis shoes/sneakers or character shoes. No Flip Flops or short skirts.

Acting/Drama: This class gives students a taste of what it means to be an actor. Students in this class will leave with a basic understanding of theatre fundamentals including stage directions and blocking, theatre terminology and a brief history of theatre. They will also explore improv, scene study and performance as well as learn how to audition for a play. Dress Code: Any comfortable and moveable clothing, tennis shoes/sneakers or character shoes. No Flip Flops or short skirts.

Hip Hop: For boys and girls. Street dance meets stylized music in this high-energy (almost aerobic!) class. Isolations, footwork, and rhythms get faster and more challenging as dancers progress. And don't worry—we always emphasize age-appropriate moves and music. This is an encouraging opportunity to express their free-style movements, fostering their own unique style and building their self-confidence. Dress Code: Any comfortable and moveable clothing, high-top sneakers.

Little Princesses Ballet/Tap Ages 3-6: A fun combination class which introduces ballet and tap skills, while using creative movement techniques in order to develop body awareness, and spatial perceptions. Ballet is the foundation of all dance forms. Students are instructed in proper body placement, alignment, balance and control. Also proper terminology and ballet technique. Tappers develop outstanding coordination, musicality, and rhythm as they progress from basic to more intricate and complex patterns. Dress Code: Any style pink leotard, pink tights, pink ballet shoes, black tap shoes, supplied skirt & tiara.
